**BIS was McDonald's Donurie's Quantum Of Solace  
RBIS Golby's Ciboney Fagan at Shadymore  
BP Fisher's Zalindor Chinggis Khan.**

**MPD 1 Fisher's Zalindor Chinggis Khan, moved out well for his age. Quite a strong head, neck flowed into good topline. Lovely tight feet, eye colour good. Well balanced youngster. BPD & BP; 2 Townsend's Daxpack Risktaker Rainscote, close up to 1, with good body shape. Front movement let him down but will tighten as he matures. Good topline & lovely tight feet. RBP; 3 Harris' Szajani Szeder, three very promising youngsters.**

**PD 1 D Risktaker Rainscote.**

**JD 1 Savage's Karaszy's Falco Peregrinus at Silvestre, sound youngster. Lean head, skull a little longer than muzzle. Neck flowed into good topline & tailset. Straight drop of hocks when stacked. Overall giving a good balanced picture; 2 Bornett's Roughshoot Ishmael, smart young dog, good in profile when stacked & on movement. A little lean for me, maturing well; 3 Bennett & Howard's Artilysminiz Wisteria.**

**YD 1 McDonald & Roe's Kericastelli Czar by Pirospont, super young dog, caught my eye when he entered the ring. Well constructed, which showed with his excellent ground covering movement. Well handled. RCC; 2 Green & Bradley's Vizslanya Vador by Vizsaset, first impression was a strong solid dog with excellent bone. Hands on showed a dog who could a day's work, but not coarse in any way. Unlucky to come up against 1; 3 Robert's Parrazi Point at Billingbriar.**

**PGD 1 Underdown's Zahur Zambala, difficult class to judge, not finding the construction I was looking for. Good level topline & tailset, tight feet. Good eye colour & shape; 2 Webb's Karrouki Windrunner, very nervous dog, unable to assess him. Decent dog hidden away there; 3 Fowler's Follyhall Wild Boy.**

**LD 1 Woodcock's Glengamna Oska, very smart dog, lovely head & gentle expression. Well sprung ribs, balanced front & rear angulation. Moved out well on tight feet; 2 Dasilva's Bournehouse Crispin, another very smart dog, difficult to separate from 1, same comments apply. Shown in excellent condition; 3 Jones & Cutty's Sulisminerva Liber von Logizspark.**

**OD 1 Golby's Ciboney Fagan at Shadymore, shown in excellent condition. Lean head, strong arched neck, level topline, correct front & rear angulation. Ground covering movement with excellent reach. Delighted to award him CC & RBIS; 2 Northwood's Sh Ch**

**Hookside Gabor, a dog I have admired from the ringside. Classic head with gentle expression, balanced front & rear angulation. Moved out well, holding topline correctly. Shown in excellent condition; 3 Savage's Bitcon Skymaster with Silvestre.**

**VD 1 Bergin's Aus/Sh Ch Hanafor The Xecutioner, excellent example of the breed. Noble head & expression, correct topline & tailset. Moved out well, covering the ground with ease; 2 Jones & Cutty's Alfizsbet The Upstart, another very smart veteran. Lovely head & expression, well made neck into level topline. Lost out today on close front movement; 3 Bornett's Zavis Loch Loyle.**

**MPB 1 Barnard's Daxpack Henrietta, what a lovely eyecatching puppy. Feminine head, correct eye colour & shape. Good neck & shoulders, & correct depth to chest. Good topline & tailset. Very balanced for one so young, moved out with confidence, covering the ground with ease. I'm sure she has an exciting future ahead. Sadly, she was unable to remain to challenge for BP; 2 Cameron's Bitcon Skyfall at Kasprowy, another very promising, eyecatching puppy. Well proportioned head, good neck & shoulders flowing into level topline. Excellent forechest & depth of brisket. Moved really well when lead was slackened; 3 Colyer's Peathill Caol Ila.**

**PB 1 D Henrietta. JB 1 Savage's Roughshoot Infra Red at Silvestre, super 14 month old youngster. Everything to like about her. Feminine head, good neck & shoulders & depth of chest. Held topline when moved, balanced youngster; 2 Rutherford's Kincsem Pussy Galore, another excellent youngster, close up to 1. Classic head, firm topline, good depth of brisket. Angulation correct front & rear, straight hocks, moved out well; 3 Digby's Alsziv Laurona.**

**YB 1 Morton's Andronja Sweet Sixteen, very close class, some lovely young bitches here. Just my type, pretty feminine head, good eye colour, neck & shoulder placement. Strong level topline, correct hind angulation. Lovely tight feet. Moved with ground covering stride; 2 Earl's Daxpack Ouija Board to Bonnyshoot, excellent quality young bitch. Feminine head, clean neck into correct shoulders. Good outline with correct tailset. Balanced angles front & rear, moved out freely; 3 Belton's Flushpoint Special Edition.**

**PGB 1 Dasilva & Sexton's Ertekes Beaujolais, feminine head with correct eye shape & colour. Clean neck into good topline. Excellent forechest & depth of brisket. Good turn of stifle, moved out soundly; 2 Mill's Karrouki Windflower, well schooled youngster, showed free-standing. Pretty feminine head, almond eye of good colour. Excellent forechest, depth of brisket, good straight let down on hocks. Moved out well; 3 Woodcock's Glengamna Katiya.**

**LB 1 McDonald's Donurie's Quantum Of Solace, what a lovely bitch. Have admired her from ringside, & was not disappointed when hands-on. Could not fault her in construction and presentation. Delighted to award her the CC & BOB; 2 Allen & Bloxham's Gingibre**

Head Over Heels, on the taller side, but all in proportion. Correct Vizsla head, soft expression. Presented a well balanced outline when stacked. Flowed round the ring, one of the best movers of the day; 3 Smith's Zavis Rhapsody.

OB 1 Morton's Lux Sh Ch Karaszy's Calypso, stylish bitch with ring presence. Well constructed bitch whose proportions gave her a balanced outline. Correct angles front & rear, good drop of straight hocks. Moved freely, covering her ground; 2 Watson's Sh Ch Bitcon Magical Whispers at Oakswarren, very showy bitch, looking great when stacked. Feminine head, level topline, good turn of stifle, straight drop of hocks, moved out really well; 3 Rutherford's Kincsem Pretty Picture.

VB 1 Price's Aldom Cristal, 8 year old bitch in excellent condition. Lovely head & eye, very well constructed, strong topline & good tailset. Free movement on tight feet. RCC; 2 Bergin's Sh Ch Roughshoot Calypso, another lovely oldie in excellent condition. Well constructed throughout, good forechest & depth of brisket. Moved soundly; 3 Hudson's Sh Ch Rivellspärke Golden Glory.

FTB 1 Harris' Ch Szajani Sipos, super 6 year old working Vizsla in excellent condition. Lovely head & eye, good forehand. Strong topline & good tailset, well angulated hindquarters. Well constructed throughout, sound movement.

Brace 1 Sutherland's, two bitches, very well matched. Excellent movement, they were actually in step at one stage! Well handled; 2 Webb's, two boys who complemented each other very well, moved together soundly, well handled; 3 Bell's. Team 1 Mill's, just one brave competitor. Handled the team of three confidently & in control. Well done! Progeny 1 Aus/Sh Ch Hanafor The Xecutioner.
