I'd like to thank the Hungarian Vizsla Club for inviting me to judge these classes and to all the exhibitors who brought their dogs for me to judge. I had a lovely day. Only two exhibits in Postgraduate and one in Open were male.

Junior (3)

1 Green & Bradley's Vizslanya Vador by Vizaset, lovely 13 month old dog, masculine head without being coarse, well proportioned with median line, good earset with nice leathers, clean, moderately long neck leading to level topline with correctly set on tail carried well whilst moving with style, well angulated forequarters and pronounced breastbone, moderate rear angulation, good, catlike feet, good coat colour and size.

2 Bergin's Flushpoint Frater of Roughshoot, sweet 7 month old pup, lean, noble head, good eye colour, well set ears with nice leathers, level topline, rounded feet, nice low tailset.

3 Harris Szajani Szeder, 7 month old pup of nice size and good bone, clean neck, good breastbone, level topline. Very close decision between 2 & 3, just preferred the head of 2.

Postgraduate (15, 4a)

1 Smith's Zavis Rhapsody, pleasing 2yo bitch with good depth of chest, lovely, lean head, nice eyes, moderately low earset and nice leathers, smooth, moderately long neck leading to level topline with rather low set tail carried correctly on the move, good front angulation, moderately bent stifles, lovely colour and size.

2 Mill's Karrouki Windflower, very pretty 2yo bitch, nice head, good colour and shaped eyes, good leathers, clean neck, well angulated forequarters, nice depth of chest and spring of rib, level topline, correct hind angulation, lovely rounded feet with short toes, moved well, nice coat colour.

3 Price & Buller's B'Ignis Brunensis Locura at Aldom (Imp).

Open (11, 2a)

1 Papworth's Nicael Galacia, stylish 4yo bitch of good colour and size, very pretty, feminine head with median line, well shaped eyes with good pigmentation, correctly set ears, silky leathers, elegant neck leading to level topline, good breast bone, correct stifle angulation, nice catlike feet, good tailset and carriage, moved well.

2 Cruickshank's Topaeris Lady Marmalade, smart 4yo bitch with a pretty head, dark well shaped eye, good leathers, clean neck, prominent breastbone and deep chest, level topline, moderate hind angulation, nice feet, correct size, good gait.

3 Bergin's Sh Ch Roughshoot Calypso JW.
