My thanks also go to the exhibitors who entered with their lovely Vizslas. I was very pleased with the entry and was spoilt for choice in some classes with difficult decisions having to be made. To my steward Heather a big thank you for carrying out your task so efficiently on your own — no mean feat. When judging it is certainly a bonus to have a reliable steward.

- MPD (4). 1. Roe's Sargasbarna Rocket Man by Pirospont. Well made 9mth old puppy, mature for age. Masculine head, excellent front with deep chest, level topline, moderate angulation and overall in proportion. Moved well. BPIS.
- 2. Burley's Afanleigh Beckham. 8 mth old, not as confident or as mature in body as 1. Good front and strong hindquarters, moved ok.
- 3. Murray and Parker's Vadaszfai Csapodar at Szelkiraly (Imp Hun).
- JRD (4,2a). 1. Porter-Manning and Porter's Wallaroo Hawk Eye JW . Pleasing head with kind expression. Well balanced standing on good feet and front, well muscled for age with strong hindquarters giving him accurate movement.
- 2. Challis's Vizslanya Aragonia. Maturer than 1 but not co-operating with handler today. A bit dark in coat colour for me. Body proportions good but did not move out well.
- YD (2). 1. Harrison's Alfizsbet Pike O'Stickle von Argyros. Lovely head into strong neck and good shoulders, forechest ok. Held topline standing and on the move, elegant and light footed with good free flowing stride.
- 2. Miles' Layways van Winkle JW. Longer cast than winner, good front and tight feet. Tail a bit high set and on the day movement was not as good as 1.
- PGD (4) 1. Cruickshank's Topaeris Shadow. Pleasing medium sized dog with lovely head and expression. Strong neck into good shoulder, straight front, level topline and moderate rear angulation. A very elegant light footed dog on the move, precise coming and going and good in profile. DRCC & RBIS
- 2. Rutherford's Kincsem Its Now or Never. Not the angulation of 1 and a bit heavier in build. A powerful mover but not straight on the up and down.
- 3. Joyce's Ranchstar Vyvyan.
- LD (9). 1. Dorogi's Nemzet Kincse Orion. Had not seen this dog before but loved him. Mature without being overdone. Masculine head, good kind expression, a powerful neck into excellent shoulders, elbows close to body and correct depth of chest standing on tight feet. Level topline, good tailset and carriage. Graceful and elegant on the move as required in the Breed Standard. DCC & BIS
- 2. Munros's Wolfmeyer Glen Cannick. A more compact dog but with good body proportions, masculine with good angulation moved well.
- 3. Porter-Manning and Porter's Wallaroo All That Jazz Sh CM.
- OD (6). 1. Roe's Sargasbarna Salvo Del Pirospont. A strong mature dog, good head, eye colour and ear set with moderate stop. A well balanced medium sized boy with good bone. Handled well and

moved in an effortless but collected gait which won him the class. Did not move as well in the challenge. Hope his BPIS son follows in his footsteps.

- 2. Barrett's Karaszy's Glorious Legacy. Lighter framed and finer all through than winner but a sound dog with good front, colour and well muscled. Moved a little close behind today.
- 3. Challis' Highforce Future Legend for Vizslanya JW.
- VD (4). So good to see two full Champions in this class. 1. Northwood's Ch Hookside Gabor. 11 yr old handsome and very fit dog. A kind head and expression with very good overall body proportions. A lovely example of a male Vizsla.
- 2. Griffiths and Scott's Ch Ulurudawn Cardinal Marker. My notes say similar to 1 but front movement let him down on the day.
- 3. White's Parcroft Piros by Arunsvar.
- FTD (2). 1. Harris' Szajani Szeder. A well put together compact dog with masculine head, dark eye giving gentle expression. Excellent front, depth of chest and angulation moderate fore and aft. Moved precisely and has good action in profile.
- 2. Mills' Karrouki Windfire JW. One I had given RCC to before. However today he was just not moving or standing well.
- PB (1). 1. Grant's Sargasbarna Igazi Tulelo. Happy 11 mth old puppy of elegant build. A bit long in muzzle at present but this could change as she matures. She has good angulation and level topline, tail carriage ok. Straight front, good feet and moved ok. RBPIS.
- JB (8,3) 1. Munro's Bitcon Flame Dancer. Feminine head and expression, strong neck into well angulated shoulders. Forechest and depth of chest good for age. A compact youngster with level topline and good tailset, moved out well.
- 2. Murray & Parker's Menta of Skyrocket at Szelkiraly (Imp Hun). Lighter build all through, angulation ok, not the spring of rib of 1. Fore and aft movement accurate and elegant in profile but feel she needs to mature in body.
- 3. Harris' Goldstar Miss Teeg from Szajani (Imp USA).
- YB (3,1). 1. Hardcastle & Bradley's Vizslanya Sziena JW. Pleasing young bitch with lovely expression and kind eye. Her overall conformation is very good, with strong neck into level topline and good rear angulation. Stood on tight feet. Movement good. Just was a bit flat in the Challenge.
- 2. Hansford's Hawkpoint Peregrine. Younger than 1 and not as well schooled. Everything is there just needs to mature in body. Good coat colour and balanced on the move.
- PGB (7,2). 1. Wallington's Nicael Blue Diamond Among Ohanava. Stood out in the class, very well constructed. Feminine head, ears good and eye colour correct. Moderate angulation and topline, tail set and carriage correct. Movement excellent and pushed hard for RCC in Challenge.
- 2. Murray and Parker's Bonbrandee Lucky Penny at Szelkiraly. Different in build to winner. Liked her elegance but today she was not as together on the move.
- 3. Dorogi's Daenerys Z Labske Lhoty.

- LB (9,1) Aynsley's Recuerdo Monika of Caorunn. A very well balanced bitch with good spring of rib, forechest and front assembly. Moderate length of neck into good body proportions with substance. She moved well in the class but didn't go up and back accurately in the Challenge.
- 2. Fishlock's Afanleigh Eve. A very elegant lighter framed bitch than 1 but lots to like in her overall conformation. Just moved slightly wide in front today.
- 3. Rutherford's Kincsem Sariska
- OB (7,1). 1. Cruickshanks's Topaeris Summer Love. This bitch really stood out for me. Loved her head and expression. The Standard calls for moderate and she has that in her build. Very graceful lively trot, well muscled and good coat condition. BCC. BOS. Outmoved by her son in the RBIS challenge.
- 2.Barnard's Daxpack Lush Lashes. Taller bitch with good head and expression, good lay of shoulder and straight front with tight feet. On the day she was not as free flowing on the move as 1.
- 3. Rutherford's Kincsem Enna Llatsew.
- VB (5). 1. Allen & Bloxham's Gingibre Head Over Heels. One I gave the RCC to as a Jr. She is a tall but balanced 8 yr old with good overall shape. One of the best movers on the day.
- 2. Cruickshank's Topaeris Lady Marmalade. A very elegant 8yr old. A hard decision between the two but she was not as true out and back as 1 on the day.
- 3. Mills' Sh Ch Carwci's Phoenix ShCM.
- FTB (2). 1. Barnard's Ch Daxpack Henrietta. Feminine classic Vizsla head with strong neck flowing into good shoulder assembly, straight front with tight feet. Topline good well muscled hind quarters and she moved out well. RBCC
- 2. Mills' Karrouki Windrush D'Lyla JW Sh CM. Not as tall as winner but a very attractive bitch in overall shape and profile. Did not move as well as winner on the day.
